Consent Agenda: Larry Todd moved to approve the consent agenda. Mervin Larsen seconded the motion. All voted aye, motion carried.

Citizens Open Forum: None present.

Additions to the agenda:

New Business: Youth worker program

Good of the Board: David Cunningham absence

Lynn Sessions moved to accept the addition to the agenda. Larry Todd seconded the motion. All voted aye, motion carried.

New Business:

AAM (American Association of Museums): Larry Todd moved to approve expenses up to \$2500 for Rachel DeShong to attend the conference in Washington D. C. May 25-29. Lynn Sessions seconded the motion. All voted aye, motion carried.

Lighting – rope light estimate: Older lighting in display cases is causing items to deteriorate. David presented a bid from AC Electric to replace older lighting in cases and other areas. Youth Worker Program: Lynn Sessions moved to approve \$275 Business Contract for the Museum to participate in the program. Larry Todd seconded the motion. All voted aye, motion carried.

Budget cut priorities: Jim Allen reported the State is predicting a 35% budget drop. Work on the new budget will start soon. Priorities will be to cover wages and utilities.

Water heater/220: The board discussed the size of the new water heater in the utility room. After viewing and discussing the issue, cost of a larger model was deemed not warranted.

There may be an opportunity for a tour to a dig site this summer. Second stop was at the Washakie Museum in Worland. The tour included the back scenes and collections.
