Committee Reports:

The Strategic Committee: The committee met with David and Alex to begin work on the Strategic Plan. They identified ten items critical to future accreditation, items that the Museum cannot afford at this time, four goals for the future and ways to measure progress.

Alex is working on the Collections Management Plan drafted by the previous manager.

identify more areas of the plan that can be developed during times of tight budgets.
